

Lifting of the Temporary Moratorium
on Processing Applications for Registration of Additional Qualifications

The Dental Council and its Education and Accreditation Committee (“EAC”) decided in March 2009 to impose a temporary moratorium in respect of applications for registering new additional qualifications pending a full review of the relevant policy. The Council has endorsed a set of new vetting guidelines, entitled the “Guidelines for Inclusion of Qualifications in the List of Registrable/Quotable Additional Qualifications” (with effect from 1 November 2010) (the “New Guidelines”).

The New Guidelines are promulgated for use with effect from 1 November 2010 thereby lifting the temporary moratorium on the same date. Applications for registering additional qualifications will be processed in accordance with the New Guidelines with immediate effect.
