<Note> Pursuant to section 13 of the Dentists Registration Ordinance, the publication of a list of all registered dentists in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette shall be prima facie evidence that the person named in such list is registered with the Dental Council. **The information on the Gazette should contain the name, registered addresses, qualifications and dates of qualifications of each dentist.** Since it is required that the Gazette has to be printed in both Chinese and English, the names and addresses of the list of registered dentists are required to be provided in Chinese where applicable, in addition to the English version.

Statement of Purposes

Purpose of Collection

1. The personal data are provided by dental practitioners to the Dental Council for the purpose of facilitating the provisions of the Dentists Registration Ordinance (Cap. 156, Laws of Hong Kong). The provision of personal data is obligatory under the same Ordinance.

Classes of Transferees

2. The personal data you provide are mainly for use within the Dental Council but they may also be disclosed to other Government branches/departments, agencies or authorities for the purposes mentioned in paragraph 1 above, if required. The Public can access to your gazette information relating to names, addresses, qualifications and dates of the qualifications. Apart from this, your other personal particulars and information will only be disclosed to parties where you have given consent to such disclosure or where such disclosure is allowed under the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance.

Access to personal Data

3. You have a right of access and correction with respect to personal data as provided for in sections 18 and 22 and Principle 6 of Schedule 1 of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance. Your right of access includes the right to obtain a copy of your personal data provided by you during the occasions as mentioned in paragraph 1 above. A fee may be imposed for complying with a data access request.

Application for registration as a dentist on Non-resident List

- 1) Complete and return the attached application forms and evidence of identity.
- 2) If you are a graduate from the University of Hong Kong, please present the original and provide one copy of your temporary certificate from the University of Hong Kong.

If you are a candidate who have passed the Licensing Examination of the Dental Council, please submit a Certificate of Good Standing issued by the Dental Council/Board with which you are currently registered/last registered (any certificate issued for more than 3 months will be counted invalid), or a certificate of good character from the dental school if you have never practised dentistry after graduation.

- 3) Present the original and provide one copy of your Hong Kong Identity Card (or your passport if you do not have a Hong Kong Identity Card).
- 4) Submit three passport size photographs.
- 5) Submit a cheque/bank's draft for HK\$2,170*, as registration fee made payable to "The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region".

Note to Applicants

Waiver of Registration and Related Fees for Healthcare Professionals

As a token of appreciation to healthcare professionals in the fight against coronavirus disease-2019, the fees payable in respect of statutory registration / enrolment as well as issuance and/or renewal of practising certificates for 13 healthcare professions that take effect during the 3-year concession period from 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2023 will be waived by the Government if certain criteria are met.

2. Pursuant to Dentists (Fee Concessions) Regulation 2020, the fees payable for the first time registration in the General Register and Specialist Register and the issuance and/or renewal of practising certificates for up to 3 times that first take effect during the concession period will be waived.
